

Researchers at UCSF are recruiting **14-16 year-old autistic and non-autistic girls** to participate in our study about **emotional and social experiences**

- **Who can participate?**
 - 14-16 year-old girls with and without autism and their caregiver with smartphone access
- **What do you need to do?**
 - Participate in two waves of data collection
 - For each wave: complete one clinical visit/interview and questionnaires, respond to short surveys on an app and wear Fitbit for 2 weeks
- **How long will the study take?**
 - You will be in the study for two separate weeks that are 3 months apart.
- **What can you get out of the study?**
 - There won't be any direct benefit to you but you will be helping with science
 - Adolescents will be compensated \$75 for each wave of data collection, and \$25 for each post-study interview, for total up to \$200; Caregivers will receive \$25 for answering surveys
 - You can also keep the Fitbit Charge 6 after completing the full study
